The south-west quarter contained a ninepin bowling alley and paths through a wilderness of trees and shrub planting.

## South-west Quarter

- Restore the ninepin alley in the western compartment • of the middle terrace, to complete the Bridgeman and Pope landscape of the early 18th century.
- Improve habitats and biodiversity promote access to nature.
- Reintroduce gravel path network within the wilderness. ٠
- Coppice existing yews and holly to regenerate planting stock.
- Create evergreen enclosures and hedging. ٠
- Remove dilapidated timber palisade fencing. • Explore opportunities for managed extensive volunteer •
- tree planting projects. Recreate the planted palisade. •
- Provision of a weatherproof buggy store. •
