as stated above —


~~do not constitute or involve development of land within the meaning of the Town

NOTE

1. Any person who desires to appeal against the decision of the local planning authority, or on the failure of a local planning authority to give notice of their determination or of the reference of the application to the Secretary of State, within the period allowed, e.g., two months or such extended time as may have been agreed upon in writing between the applicant and the local planning authority, must give notice of appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DJ, within six months of the date of notice of the determination, or of expiry of the period allowed referred to in the above, as the case may be, or such longer period as the Secretary of State may allow. Such person shall also furnish a copy of the following documents:-
 - (i) the application made to the local planning authority;
 - (ii) any relevant plans, drawings and particulars submitted to them;
 - (iii) the notice of determination, if any;
 - (iv) all other relevant correspondence with the local planning authority.

2. If the determination is to the effect that planning permission is required, and you therefore wish to apply for such permission, you should notify the Director of Technical Services - Planning Division, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ, so that he can give you the appropriate forms.
