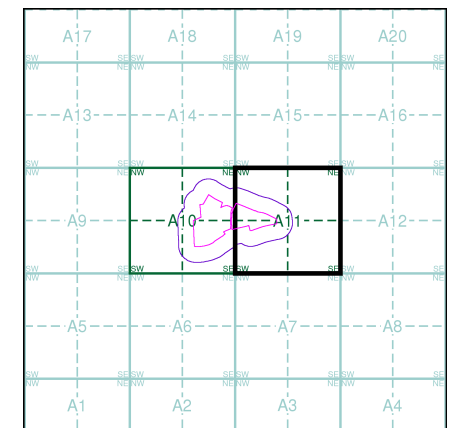
The Historical Aerial Photos were produced by the Ordnance Survey at a scale of 1:1,250 and 1:10,560 from Air Force photography. They were produced between 1944 and 1951 as an interim measure, pending preparation of conventional mapping, due to post war resource shortages. New security measures in the 1950's meant that every photograph was re-checked for potentially unsafe information with security sites replaced by fake fields or clouds. The original editions were withdrawn and only later made available after a period of fifty years although due to the accuracy of the editing, without viewing both revisions it is not easy to spot the edits. Where available Landmark have included both revisions.

I refer to your recent contaminated land enquiry for a site at The Stag Brewery, Lower Richmond Road, London SW14 7ET.

Richmond Council, as a Local Authority, has a duty under Part 2A of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, to investigate its area for the purpose of identifying contaminated land. In fulfilment of this duty we have compiled a database of land that may be potentially contaminated based on the locations of former historical industrial land uses within the borough. The database currently holds close to 1,500 records.

We have searched our database in response to your enquiry. A table showing all the industrial land use records that were identified by the search of our database is given in the appendix to this response.

In relation to your question about gas membranes, ground conditions and made ground I am unaware of any contaminated land site investigations or remediation having taken place at the site itself, so do not have any site specific information. However as you will see from the report below, there has been an adjacent site investigation which was related to a planning application (Reference: 09/1490/FUL).

Unfortunately, I am unable to answer the questions that relate to the drainage and flood risk for this site. I would suggest that you contact the Councils Flood Risk Officer who I think is called Andrea Kitzberg

I would like draw your particular attention to the standard disclaimer notice below.

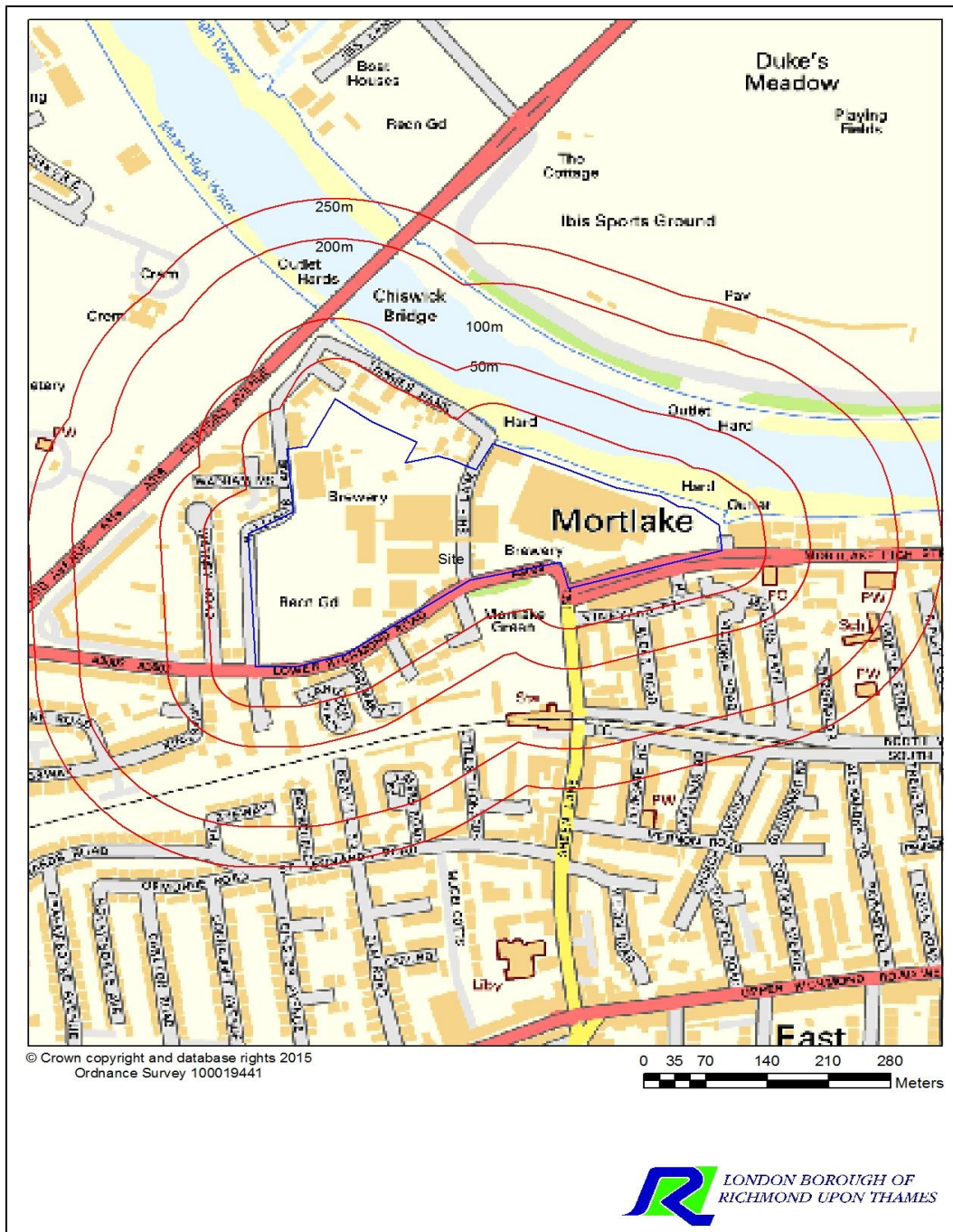

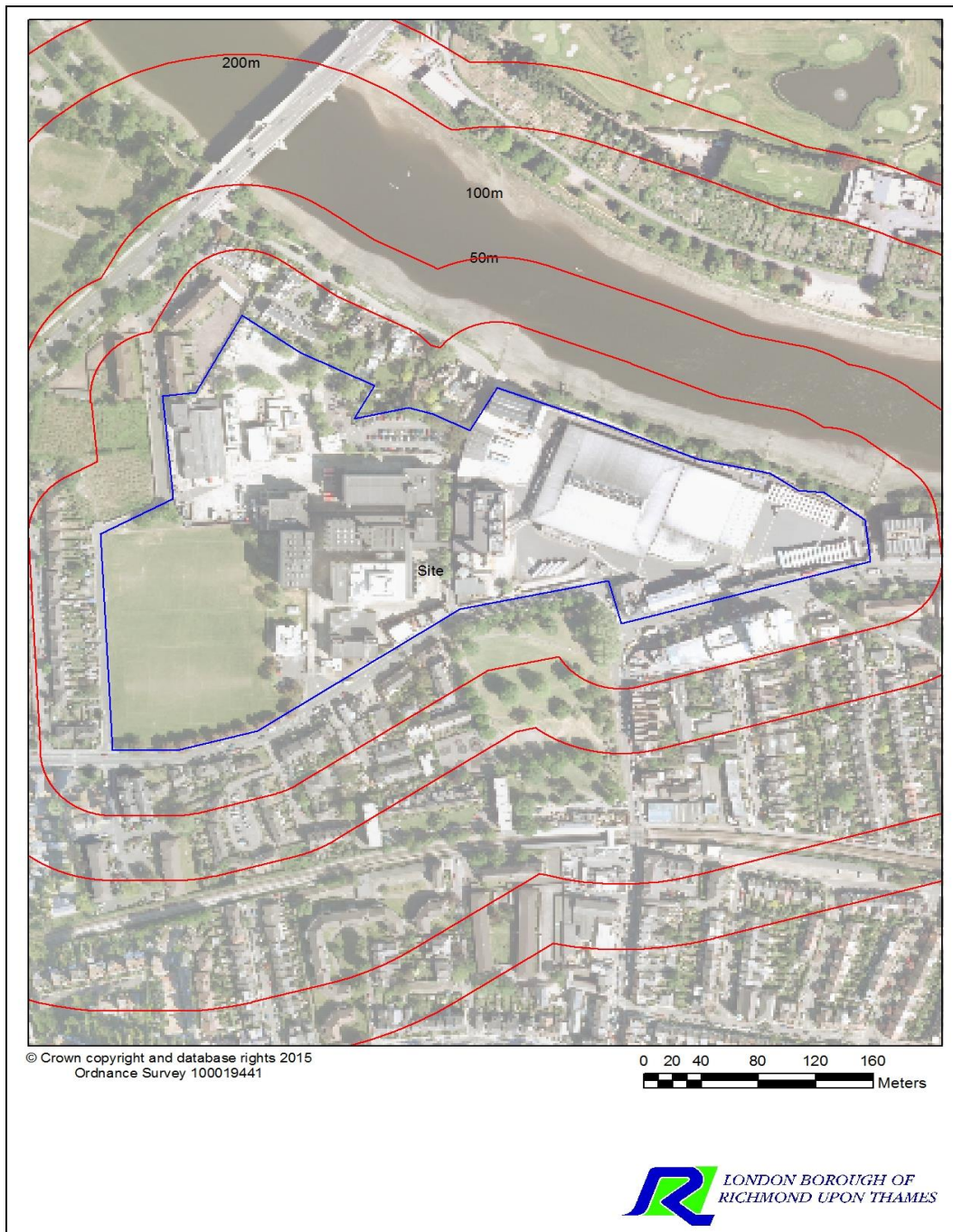

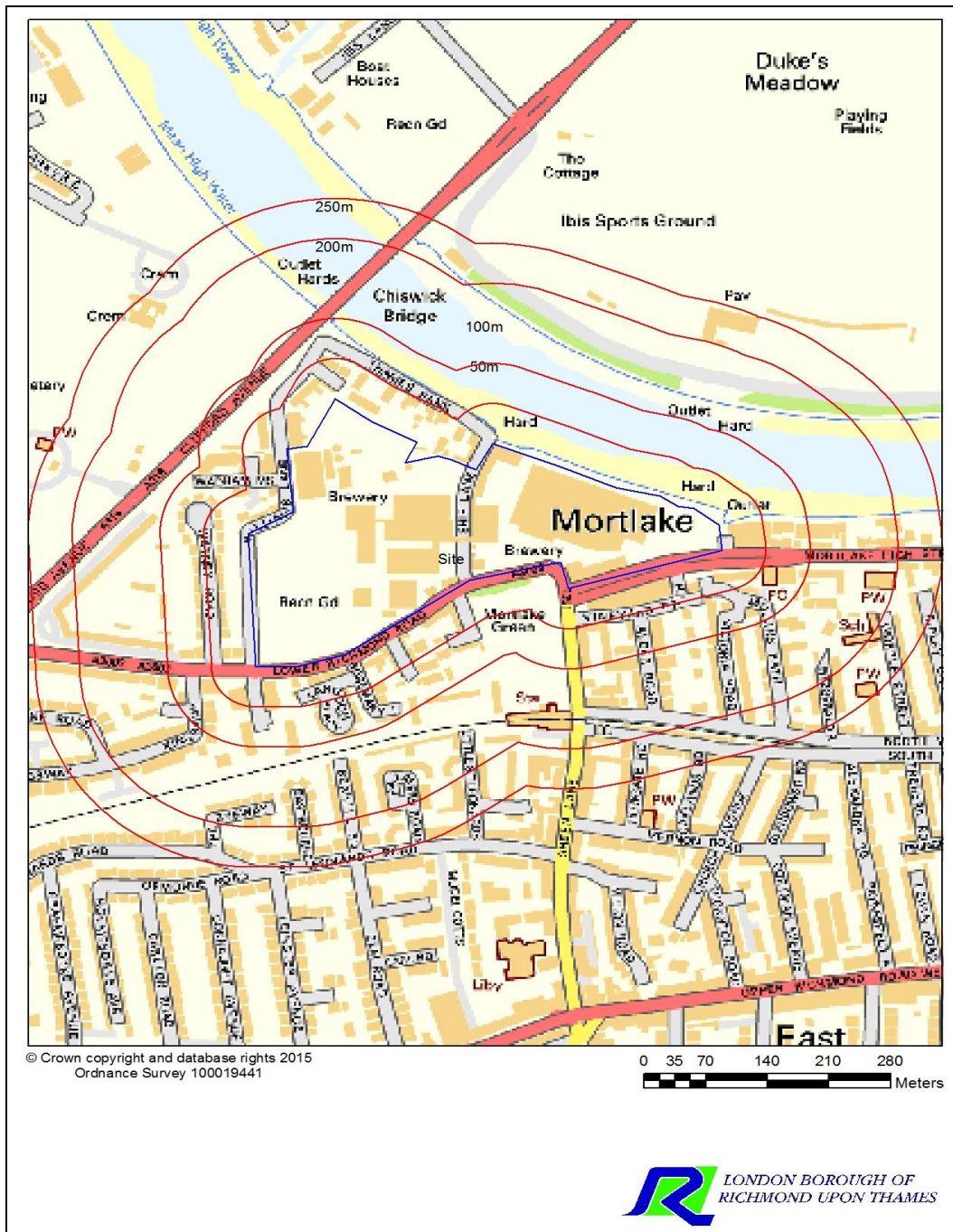
