**Comment:** I have been impressed by, and support without repeating, the objections of Mrs Baines and Cllr Avon, and sympathize with those who live at Chertsey Court, who seem to be faced with an attack on their private land rights. I'm not at all happy about the proposed brewery development, which I understand is the cause of this reconfiguration, but that's a separate matter. You must know that road improvements have the effect of increasing traffic; I suspect that will happen here. The expense will have no material effect on journey times, even without the new dwellings on the brewery site. At the moment provision for bicycle riders here, and going west along the A316, is very poor. I rarely use the bicycle lanes, preferring to take my chance in the road. I see no improvement.
