Comment: Chalkers Corner is already one of the most polluted junctions in S W London. Air toxins are more than 50 per cent above the legal limit. The plan proposes to increase the already noxious air fumes and noise putting the health of our children and elderly residents at greater risk this is inexcusable. There is also the increased risk of crossing the roads for our children and elderly and several families already suffer from pollution related conditions.
