**Comment:** The changes do not appear sufficient to deal with the already excessive traffic and congestion in this area, let alone the forecasted increase due to the new developments.

The provision for cycling is particularly pathetic. The use of ASLs is a dangerous placebo that does nothing to improve safety or access. The pitifully short area of paint denoted as a cycle lane in front of the bus stop is no use whatsoever.

The developers, the council and TFL should be prioritising walking and cycling, especially considering the proposal to build a new school on this site. Protected cycle lanes, at least at the junctions, that are connected to useable sections of cycling infrastructure going towards Richmond, Sheen and Barnes should be included.
