**Comment:** I find it wholly unacceptable that so many mature trees, which mitigate the effects of traffic pollution, being uprooted to make way for a road scheme with dubious benefits to traffic flow. It is quite wrong to subject the residents of Chertsey Court to even greater levels of noise and pollution and to remove the amenity that said trees currently impart.

Chalkers Corner is a very problematic junction due to the intersection of so many major trunk routes with very limited capacity for traffic coming from Lower Richmond Road to queue to turn right into Mortlake Road. Tailbacks frequently extend back to Mortlake High Street and even to White Hart Lane at busy periods. I don't see how the proposed scheme will change that.
