### Comments

**Comment:** Re configuring Chalkers Corner is the developers response to the increase in traffic that is a consequence of the proposed development and the 40% increase in local population. Estimates indicate that there will be 500 more vehicle trips in the morning rush hour. So re configuring the corner will not prevent the gridlock that those who live in Mortlake will experience on a daily basis and the detrimental impact this will have on the local and surrounding areas. Already the Chalkers Corner air quality is currently breaching both UK and EU levels. This increase in traffic will mean pollution levels will be nearly double the EU target. This will be detrimental to the health of those in neighbouring areas. No environmental study appears to have been conducted on the environmental impact of this. There also appears not to have been any consideration of providing another exit or entry to the site from Chiswick bridge to Williams Lane. Currently this is an area of grassland with a footpath going up onto Chiswick Bridge. Could this not be turned into a one way road access out of the proposed development avoiding Chalkers corner and enabling traffic to have another way to leave the development.
