**Comment:** I have objected to Application A of the proposed Brewery redevelopment, and object to Application C too.

The proposed widening of Chalkers Corner seems designed to increase traffic into the area. Mortlake Green has an over capacity level crossing - this is officially noted to be unsafe for pedestrians and especially children to use. We also have regular sitting traffic that creates significant levels of noise and air pollution - a fact demonstrated by the number of permanent signs needed on the Green to ask drivers to switch off their engines.

The widening will also remove old trees that help combat this air pollution - and seems to be likely to diminish the quality of life of the Chertsey Court residents.

The Stag redevelopment has no plan, or it seems interest in, the impact of the traffic it will create and encourage. By addressing Application A and Application C together - car use must be discouraged by the

council. If not there will be a long term problem that will be impossible to fix as there is simply no additional space for the additional cars.
