**Comment:** Pollution levels at Chertsey Court are already well above guideline levels, and we already suffer from the noise of traffic from both the A316 and Lower Richmond Road. The proposed changes at Chalkers Corner will make both things much worse for me as a resident of Chertsey Court. As a Borough proud of its green spaces, Richmond should not support a proposal to cut down beautiful 80-year chestnut trees to create more road and parking space. As a borough we should be doing more to reduce traffic and pollution, not encouraging it.

The changes do not seem necessary or helpful. The proposed residential development at the Stag Brewery site will not generate substantial traffic (see Barnes Waterside for comparison, where concerns over traffic turned out to be completely unfounded). If a school is built, the Council should do everything to discourage parents taking their children by car - as is the case in Bromley (and the primary school in Mortlake). There should be no parking or drop off points for cars, but rather measures to ensure there is adequate public transport.
