Comment: This proposal gives very little thoughts to sustainable transportation.

It is essential to increase road capacity in the light of the brewery development and prioritising cars just won't do the job. Cycling allows many more users in relation to space and as most journeys are under 2 miles, it is perfectly reasonable to prioritise it.

- 1. Existing Fully segregated cycle lanes should be joined up along the a316 to link Chiswick bridge with lower Richmond road.
- 2. There should be fully segregated cycle lanes going to Mortlake.
