The Section 106 Agreement defines the Landscape Strategy as: "A strategy for the landscaping to be delivered on the Site including the planting of not less than 300 (three hundred) trees approved pursuant to a condition U08049 to the draft Planning Permission at Schedule 1 of this Agreement."

In accordance with condition U08049 there must be at least 300 trees planted. The table below is what is proposed across each Development Zone:
