CONDITIONS:

AC01 DEVELOPMENT BEGUN WITHIN 5 YRS

The development to which this permission relates must be begun not later than the expiration of five years beginning with the date of this permission.

REASON: To conform with the requirements of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

BD11U MISCELLANEOUS-DETAILS

The lighting columns shall not be constructed otherwise than in accordance with details to be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority, such details to specify the design and external finishes thereof.

REASON: To ensure that the proposed development is in keeping with the existing building(s) and does not prejudice the appearance of the locality.

BD12U DETAILS MATS TO BE APPROVED

The new running track and associated areas and perimeter railings shall not be constructed other than in materials details/samples of which shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

NS01U NON-STANDARD

REASON: In the interests of the residential amenities of the surrounding properties.

NS03U NON-STANDARD

No development shall take place until a tree specialist report, including an assessment/statement from a reputable tree moving contractor, to demonstrate the viability of repositioning trees and details of a maintenance programme has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. Should the report fail to demonstrate that such trees can be successfully moved, then a high quality compensatory replacement planting scheme with semi-mature trees will need to accompany the tree specialist report.

REASON: In the interests of good arboricultural practice in order to safeguard the longevity, health and appearance of the trees and to ensure satisfactory replacement of trees on site.
