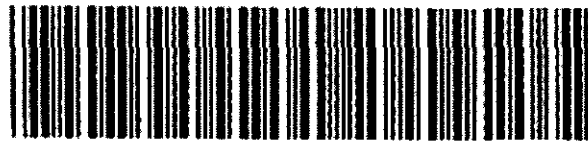

The condition(s) and/or informative(s) applicable to this application are as follows:

CONDITIONS:

AC01 DEVELOPMENT BEGUN WITHIN 5 YRS

The development to which this permission relates must be begun not later than the expiration of five years beginning with the date of this permission.

REASON: To conform with the requirements of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

BD11U MISCELLANEOUS DETAILS

The brickwork, tiles and detailing around the windows and entrance shall not be constructed otherwise than in accordance with details to be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority, such details to specify the design and external finishes thereof.

REASON: To ensure that the proposed development is in keeping with the existing building(s) and does not prejudice the appearance of the locality.

DV02AU BOUNDARY FENCING-DEVT COMMENCEMENT

No development shall take place until there has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority a plan indicating the positions, design, materials and type of boundary treatment to be erected. The boundary treatment shall be completed before the building is occupied or in accordance with a timetable agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.

REASON: To safeguard the visual amenities of the locality and the privacy/amenities of the adjoining properties.

DV15U WNDWS OBSCURE GLZD & NONOPENBL

The proposed hall window on the ground floor and the shower-room window on the first floor in the south-east elevation of the building hereby approved shall at no time be openable or glazed, otherwise than in obscured glass, below a minimum height of 1.75 metres (5'7") above the relevant floor level.

REASON: To ensure that the proposed development does not prejudice the amenities of adjoining occupiers.

DV17A DUSTBIN ENCLOSURE REQUIRED

None of the buildings hereby approved shall be occupied until a dustbin enclosure has been provided in accordance with detailed drawings to be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority, such drawings to show the siting and design thereof.

REASON: To safeguard the appearance of the property and the amenities of the area.

GD02A RESTRICT ON ALT'S/EXTNS GENERAL AMENITY

Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (or any Order revoking or re-enacting that Order) no external alterations or extensions shall be carried out to the building(s) hereby approved.

REASON: To safeguard the amenities of the occupiers of adjoining property and the area generally.

L111AU LANDSCAPING REQUIRED HARD AND SOFT

No development shall take place until full details of both hard and soft landscaping works have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority and these works shall be carried out as approved. These details shall include proposed finished levels or contours; means of enclosure; pedestrian access and circulation areas; hard surfacing materials; minor artefacts and structures (e.g. furniture, play equipment, refuse or other storage units, signs, lighting etc.); proposed and existing functional services above and below ground (e.g. drainage, power, communications cables, pipelines etc, indicating lines, manholes, supports etc); retained historic landscape features and proposals for restoration, where relevant]. Soft landscape works shall include planting plans; written specifications (including cultivation and other operations associated with plant and grass establishment); schedules of plants, noting species, plant sizes and proposed numbers/densities where appropriate; implementation programme.

REASON: To ensure that the proposed development does not prejudice the appearance of the locality and to preserve and enhance nature conservation interests.

LA30 LANDSCAPE WORKS IMPLEMENTATION

All hard and soft landscape works shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details. The works shall be carried out prior to the occupation of any part of the development or in accordance with the programme agreed with the Local Planning Authority.

REASON: To ensure that the proposed development does not prejudice the appearance of the locality.

Site, history and proposal:

The application building is a modern flat-roofed 3-storey building sitting towards the southern end of the campus, some 200m away from the main listed building in the northern part of the site. A smaller listed building (the Chapel in the Woods) lies about 36m to the north of the application building. The nearby Waldegrave Road boundary enjoys extensive, but not unbroken, tree cover which partially screens the site from public viewpoints.

The proposal involves installing a 3.166m x 3.466m x 2.704m high equipment cabin and a 6m overall height stub tower with antennae, all on the flat roof of the building. The proposed work is Permitted Development, on condition that the applicant gives the Local Planning Authority the opportunity to grant or withhold Prior Approval, which means that the siting and appearance of the equipment may be considered by this Council. The work may proceed only if the Council grants Prior Approval, or fails to issue a determination within 56 days. A decision must therefore be issued by 5 November 2002, or permission is deemed to be granted by default.

A similar application was recently refused on the 56th day, the reason for refusal being:-

The proposed antennae, stub tower, cabin and other equipment by reason of their size, design, siting and proximity to other similar equipment either installed or capable of being lawfully installed on this building would be visually obtrusive and detrimental to the character and appearance of the area in the event of the existing tree screen on the Waldegrave Road site boundary being wholly or partially removed or thinned, either naturally or intentionally. In the absence of assurances that the screen would be retained, the proposal would thereby be contrary to policies ENV 12, 19 and 31 of the adopted Unitary Development Plan and policies ENV 10, BLT 11 and 24 of the emerging Unitary Development Plan First Review.

The "other similar equipment" referred to above was intended to refer to a stub tower and antennae approved ref 00/3442/TEL but not yet installed.

The current application differs from that refused in that the drawings state that the conifer screen would be retained. A copy of a letter from the college to their managing agents has been provided – this confirms the college's intention to retain the tree screen at approximately its current height for the duration of the lease, and that any diseased trees will be replaced as necessary. The agent for the current application has stated that Orange have confirmed that as long as they are on the premises they will replace any trees so as to maintain the screen.

The applicant has supplied a supporting statement whose main points are:-

1. Tests have been carried out which show that the proposed height of 6m is necessary to provide coverage (a 4m option was therefore not considered acceptable)
2. Mobile coverage in the area is deficient
3. There are no other suitable buildings in this residential area
4. The installation would comply with ICNIRP (the International Commission on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection) restrictions on radiation levels.

An application for a larger installation was refused ref 01/0782/TEL

Public and other representations:

One local resident objects that the installation would change the outlook for nearby residents and the public and would cause overshadowing. The tree screen is inadequate and the Strawberry Hill Conservation Area starts only 50m away from the mast.

English Heritage consider the installation to be far enough away from the listed buildings to avoid detriment to them or the registered historic gardens.

The Garden History Society do not wish to comment.

Professional comments:

The installation would not be widely visible from off-site viewpoints because of the tree screen and would not in my view have a significant impact on the character of the area. The conservation area boundary is about 78m away and would not be affected.

In the presence of the information provided on the need for this particular site, and the certificate of compliance with safety legislation, I feel that the application may be approved. I suggest below a condition aimed at reinforcing the applicant's assurances as to the future of the tree screen.

I therefore recommend PERMISSION, subject to the following conditions and informatives.

Non-standard conditions:

NS01 - For as long as the equipment is in place on the building, the tree screen on the western site boundary shall be retained and maintained so as to provide an effective visual screen to the satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority.
REASON: to ensure that the proposed development does not prejudice the appearance of the locality.
