Comment: English Heritage have recognised the strong feelings around the redevelopment of the park and have worked with many of the local community to resolve the issues people felt strongly about:

EH have removed the impact to the abutting properties with the new improvements being made to the current café rather than a rebuild.

The felling of 347 trees has now been greatly reduced and the promise of new tree plantings. My only concern is the proposed tree lines at the back of the house. It would be good if this were reconsidered.

The terrible impact of increased traffic and pollution within surrounding roads and area- with the reduction of the café size and with promised better signage this is less of an issue to the surrounding roads, but I feel the Council should ensure proper measures are put in place

Endangering wildlife and some protected species-EH are now committed to trying to protect and in fact encourage the bio diversity within the park

We are concerned about any unnecessary fencing being placed that would prevent people and dog walkers having full use of all areas of the park
