


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
## 10k Raster Mapping **Published 2006** Source map scale - 1:10,000

Road names are also included together with the relevant road number and classification. Boundary information depiction includes county, unitary authority, district, civil parish and constituency.



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


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
## **VectorMap Local Published 2018** Source map scale - 1:10,000
