The proposed plans include buildings several stories higher than the surrounding housing which will then dwarf these, interfering with views and light. Also will be unpleasant for the anyone living in the 5 story building when the planes go over head. We live in a 2 story and planes are deafening can't imagine how a 5 story building will withstand the noise and vibrations.

This will also hugely impact traffic generation and highway safety with the number of cars negotiating the narrow roads in the area increasing dramatically.
