Comments

Comment: I am concerned about the density of the development and lack of benefit to existing residents:

- 1. Based on the plans there is not enough play space for the predicted number of children and there is no real effort to open access to the River Crane
- 2. There will be a big increase in populations and traffic on our narrow roads particularly near the entrances.
- 3. The additional families to the area will add more pressure to our schools
- 4. There is only 1 parking space per residence which will be insufficient especially with increased visitors. They will not have residence parking, but I would like more assurance for the future as we fought several years for our residence parking which has made a positive impact on our living. There is also not enough parking provision for the commercial properties.
- 5. The urban feel and height of the development is totally out of character with the current low-medium density nature of our suburban area, which will look out of place and cause privacy and overlooking issues for many of us.
- 6. I also have concerns about the disruption (noise and traffic, turning issues for large vehicles etc) caused by construction traffic during the building process, which will not be insignificant

As a neighbourhood we have worked hard to develop a very strong community in our streets and I feel that a development of this nature is too big and will impact on our wellbeing.
