**Comment:** I most strongly object. This proposed development is way, way too dense for this area. It will completely unbalance the density of the population.

At present, in the proposed development, there is less than one parking space per family. Many families of the income bracket expected by this development own two cars, especially those with children. The proposed 108 children, by the way, will quickly grow up, and being unable or unwilling to leave home at the age of 17 will be able to buy a car which will then double the amount of vehicles requiring parking. The area is already swamped with cars, there is no more available space for parking.

Apart from the parking-disaster waiting to happen, the are other factors I object to.

The heights and appearance of the buildings at the Gould road end of Crane Road is detrimental to the whole area, out of place and out of context to the small-scale Victorian development.

The proposed buildings will all overlook our back gardens meaning a total loss of privacy.
