Comment: Traffic, congestion, road safety issues and access issues will be created to the immediate and surrounding areas during the construction and on completion of the proposed highly dense development.

What research has been carried out regarding the above as it is at present? What research has been carried out to predict

the impact of construction (including construction workers) and then on completion by a further 116 (family) units? The effect of the newly implemented CPZs can already be plainly observed in Meadway and the entrance to Lincoln Avenue. This situation already means that on frequent occasions fire engines would not be able to enter Lincoln Avenue from the Meadway and vice versa. Indeed the gridlock at peak times in the area is evident. This has, in my opinion, made the 'crossing' over Meadway into Kneller Gardens far more dangerous and added traffic will surely just exacerbate the

situation.
