**Comment:** I wish to object the proposal.

I am a resident of Chertsey Court & do not believe that the proposed plans will benefit the residents or local area. Removing trees / reducing green areas will not only have an impact on the environment but will also have a knock on effect for the immediate area involving residents function & health.

We have limited parking facilities.

The area is already congested & pollution (air & noise) has been affecting the area for a while now but since the closure of Hammersmith Bridge the congestion on lower Richmond rd & surrounding area has increased heavily. I strongly disagree that widening the junction to allow more room for more vehicles will 'benefit' the area from a resident point of view.

If anything, I believe that it will make it worse. one of the major issues is that Mortlake station barriers will continue to still come down (currently about 45 mins each hour) so a wider junction to allow more cars which will bring more traffic (as the flow will not change due the the station barriers) therefore, more congestion, more pollution (air & noise) to the area.

There are health concerns; specifically respiratory issues with the potential increase in vehicles & air quality that will come with that.

As a Home owner, I am also concerned as to what impact the proposals will have on the value of the property in relation to any future rental / sale.
