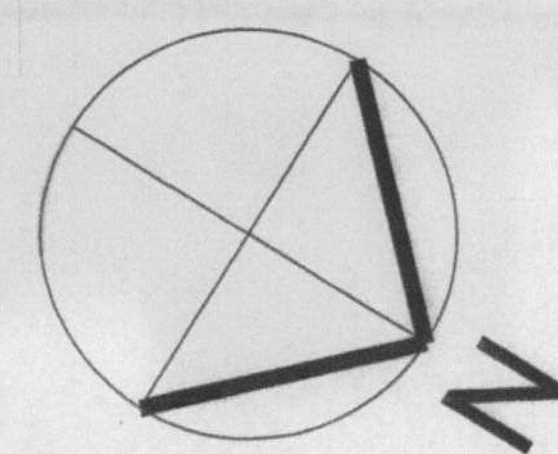

**Key to Plan**

- A Mature specimen trees. With high canopies allowing view to Gordon House from main vista.
- B Clipped box hedging formal gardens. With ornamental English style plantings within. Suitable for period of Gordon House.
- C 3m high Clipped specimen Yew Cones.
- D Clipped topiary specimens.
- E large conical clipped holly tree specimens framing entrance to Gordon House.
- F Timber planter boxes with clipped standard Bay trees. Boxes planted National Trust Green.
- G York Stone paving.
- H Stone vases set on plinths (Similar copies to those in Photographs of Gordon House gardens in 1869) Set on feature brick paved areas. Brick to match house.
- I Period style bench seats.
- J Stone Obelisk.
- K Avenue of trees framing view of Gordon House.
- L Railings section (16m in length) to create wide view of Avenue and Gordon House.
- M Courtyard driveway
