Dear Sirs,

Given the recent closure of Hammersmith Bridge there has been a significant impact on the traffic levels and congestion in East Sheen (on the Upper Richmond Road and Mortlake High street). Already heavily congested roads in East Sheen have been made much worse by the closure and if, as I am to understand, Hammersmith Bridge will not be reopened to road traffic in the foreseeable future - what impact is this going to have on the Stag Brewery redevelopment proposals?
