Dear Sirs

I have received the revised notice of planning application. Given that the closure of Hammersmith Bridge has already caused the traffic past Stag Brewery to deteriorate from bad to dreadful the scale of the redevelopment will clearly exacerbate an already poor traffic environment for local residents. Accordingly may I suggest planning should only be allowed if the developers commit to bringing all equipment and materials, including building materials, onto or off the site by river. The development has a significant riverside frontage so there should be no real problem in bringing everything required into or out of the site by barge. It simply requires the developers to undertake a little planning and purchase a few barges and tugs. The benefit to local residents would be colossal and might even mean we can drive into and out of the area without the development causing even more traffic congestion and delays. It would also minimise the damage to the environment from all the additional road traffic which would otherwise result from the redevelopment.

I would also favour the developers being required to create access to the area by tube from Chiswick Park which would enhance the whole area's communications and transport links
