The increased air pollution. The increased traffic will without doubt increase the air pollution which is even now above acceptable national and EU levels.

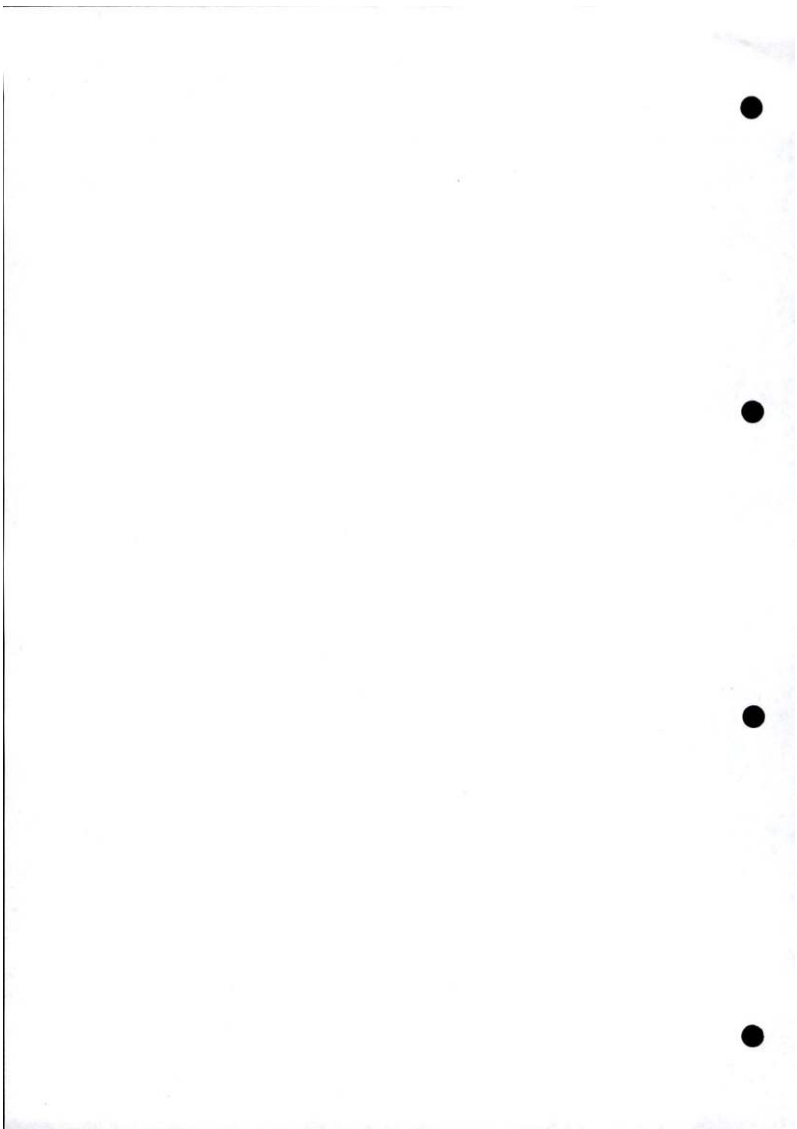
The density of units is far above that proposed in the Council's plans in 2013. More units will add even more pollution and traffic as well as pressure on parking in this area.
