I am writing to lodge my objections to the proposed development of the brewery in Mortlake. I am a resident of East Sheen, at 150 Upper Richmond Rd West, SW14.

I am objecting to the plans on the basis of the impact on the traffic, and because of the extra pressure this will place on local public transport and the level crossing.

I commute regularly into Waterloo, and I NEVER get a seat on the train. The buses into Hammersmith are already acked, and I think the situation will become untenable if the site is developed and thousands more people move to the area. The crossing is already treacherous, and additional vehicles crossing can only bring increased danger. I drive to work one day a week, and exiting the Upper Richmond Rd is a very timely endeavour. Traffic is backed up along Sheen Lane and Clifford Avenue from around 7.30am onwards. Chalked Corner is already a bottle neck for traffic during rush hour. This will get worse if thousands more people move into the brewery area. I understand that the traffic pollution in this area already exceeds EU limits.
