I am writing to confirm my objection to the development at Stag Brewery and lodge my concerns as a resident of over 20 years in East Sheen and Mortlake.

I have grave concerns, due to the increase in local population the development would encourage, about unmanageable traffic congestion, increased pollution (which is already too high/dangerous), the destruction of green spaces and a transport infrastructure that cannot meet such an increase in demand.

Whilst some development may be necessary and advantageous to the community, the scale of this current plan is unsustainable and potentially poses a danger to the existing residents - with reference to the impact on transport, increased traffic, congestion - and therefore pollution.
