I have made a summary of the construction access options, and I wish to make the following objection:

I believe that the Belgrave road access option is the worst option for all:

- It's the most dangerous access
- It's the worst for residents
- The worst for pupils
- The worst for toddlers
- The worst for the construction process

In this analysis, I have considered 4 options:

- 1. Belgrave Road
- 2. Lowther Road
- 3. School Gates
- 4. Verdun road and along the side of the playing fields

An entrance through Verdun road an along the side of the playing fields comes out as a clear winner.

Belgrave Road Option Impact:

- Huge disruption to residents who do not benefit from the construction
- Access via very narrow Single track Resident Cul De Sac where children play in the street
- Loss of resident parking spaces with no comparable alternatives
- New entrance need to be built
- There is already a multi year construction project in progress in the road
- Repair entrance / road after construction
- Possibility of blockage from meeting 419 bus
- Problems when deliveries are late due to traffic

- Possibility to run over toddlers going to Suffolk Road playground
- Possibility to run over dogs / dog walkers going to suffolk road park
- Possibility to run over school kids when school closes early
- Loss of School Putting green
- Restricted hours of delivery
- Disruption to pupils through lorry noise on "putting green"

Verdun Road Option Impact:

- Temporary loss of a small portion of playing field
- Loss of resident parking where there are lots of alternatives
