T1English Oak (Quercus robur) Rear by Car parkCrown Clean and Remove Deadwood. Final height 16m spread 8m

T2Sycamore (Acer pseudoplatanus) Rear facing car parkRemove dead stub ends. Final height 14m spread 9m T3Sycamore (Acer pseudoplatanus) Rear (At rear of lawn)Remove damaged stems and crown reduce by 3m. Final height 16 spread 7 T4Mature Sycamore - RearCrown Clean and remove major deadwood (tree does not lend itself to overall reduction without looks

being compromised). Final height 15m spread 9m

T5-T6Sycamore x 2 StemsCrown clean and remove deadwood + reduce by 3m. Final height 12m spread 4m

T7Ash (Fraxinus excelsior) in car parkCrown lift by 2m and remove deadwood.

T8Pear (Pyrus spp) by smoking shelterCrown reduce by 1m to previous reduction points. Final height 7m and spread 3m

T9Apple (Malus domestica) by smoking shelterCrown reduce by 1m to previous reduction points. Final height 4m and spread3m
