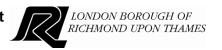

for

T1 - Holm Oak reduce the canopy by approximately 2 metres, Tree height 9 metres Crown spread 10 metres Maximum cut diameter 8cm.

Our clients wish to maintain the tree at its current dimensions to improve light filtration into the properties, prevent intrusion onto the highway and minimise the debris/excrement on the parking area. Previous pruning history leaves the tree unlikely to develop good form and structure if allowed to develop to its mature height. Approximate dimensions after pruning Height 7 metres crown spread 6 metres.

G3 Sycamore x 3 (group) Reduce the height by 2.5 - 3 metres, crown spread by 2-3 metres Tree heights 14 metres crown spread 6 metres. Dimensions after pruning. Height 11 metres, crown spread 4 metres.

We wish to maintain the canopy at the current dimensions to improve light filtration minimize debris on the parking area and help prevent future problems due to the proximity of the flats and the boundary.
