Property is a 2 bedroom Semi Detached Bungalow
Ground floor rear extension including bi-fold doors and casement window within rear elevation and variations in the side fenestration.
The proposal doesn't change the ability of fire appliances from attending the property on Hazel Close.
In addition the proposals do not alter the residents means of escape on to Hazel Close in the case of evacuation in the event of a fire.
The property will be fitted with smoke detectors in habitable rooms and hallway and heat detector in the kitchen, in addition FD 30 Doors will be fitted to the Kitchen, Bedrooms and Living room.
Building Materials and construction will be in accordance with Part B of the building regulations.
The Proposal is for a single story rear extension on a bungalow, the means of escape will be from the front door on to Hazel Close and secondary means of escape will be through the rear of the property.
In line with the Fire Safety Policy 12D(A) Preconsultation Draft March 2021 Table A1.1 Planning Applications and Information Requirements for D12(A), criteria 5 is not applicable for householder planning application.

Criteria 6. (Information on access and equipment for firefighting)	Access into the bungalow by the fire brigade if required in the event of a fire will be from the front door of the property.
General Statement	The proposed development does not alter the current ability for the Fire service to access the property or Access the road. The specification increases the fire safety for the residents over that of the existing property.
