Fire Strategy

1. Fire Resistance and Detection

- 1.1. To comply with the London Plan (2021) Policy D12, the following fire safety features will be incorporated within the subject development:
 - Use of 30-minute fire compartment wall;
 - All fire doors/doorsets to be provided with heat activated seals and flexible edge smoke brushes or blades;
 - Provision of smoke detectors throughout the unit;
 - 2 break glass points provided on shop floor with 1 in the back of house area;
 - Provision of Fire Blanket;
 - Use of vision panel doors; and
 - Emergency exit / fire exit / fire door keep shut signage placed on all relevant doors.
- 1.2. Further detail is provided on the Fire Strategy Plan enclosed at **Appendix A**.

2. Fire Evacuation

- 2.1. To comply with the London Plan (2021) Policy D12, the following fire evacuation measures will be incorporated within the subject development:
 - Automatic sliding entrance doors to be interlinked with fire alarm system and power failure. Door failsafe in open position upon activation;
 - Secondary means of escape to rear of unit;
 - Emergency exit / fire exit signage provided:
 - In the event of a fire evacuation will take place from the main entrance of the unit fronting King Street.
