DETAIL PROPOSED RESIDENTIAL ENTRANCE DOOR



New entrance door to match with the surrounding area and the existing features. The door is already on site and will be restored in order to re-use original elements of the building. The glazing units will provide the light needed into the communal entrance hall of the proposed development. This choice is to enhance the façade and aesthetics of the building with a modern entry-phone system that will provide secure access to the proposed building.



DETAIL PROPOSED REFUSE STORE ENTRANCE DOOR



New refuse store door located in the position of a blocked opening with an arched fanlight also blocked up which, it is clear as underlined in the heritage statement that was an important opening, probably for the stables. In order to enhance this element the proposed door resembles a set of stable door in painted timber, bi-folded in order to ensure the internal opening (as shown in the image below) sited within the original opening for the better appreciation of this façade. This guarantees safe and secure storage of refuse and easy collection of the bins on the appropriate days without access to the main building via Digi-lock.
