## 1. Introduction

The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 (as amended) applies to all land in England and Wales, other than land which is the subject of a special development order, and specifies various classes of development which may be undertaken without the permission of the local planning authority. Such development, referred to as "permitted development", is deemed to have planning permission by the Order, and does not require an application for planning permission to be submitted to the Council.

The applicant has submitted an application for a Certificate of Lawful Development (Proposed). In assessing this application, the Council is making a determination of law as to whether or not the proposed development complies with the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 (as amended). Issues such as the policies contained in the Council's adopted Richmond Local Plan (2018) are not to be taken into consideration as the decision is based on fact and not on policy grounds.

## 2. DESCRIPTION OF THE SITE AND ITS SURROUNDINGS

The subject site consists of a two-storey end-terrace dwellinghouse located on the west side of Laurel Avenue.

The application site is situated within Character Area 13 of the Twickenham Village Planning Guidance and is designated as:

- Article 4 Direction – restricting basement development
- Critical Drainage Area – Environment Agency
- Main centre buffer zone – Twickenham Town Centre Boundary Buffer zone
- Throughflow Catchment Area – Throughflow and Groundwater Policy zone.

## 3. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSAL AND ANY RELEVANT PLANNING HISTORY

The application proposes alterations to the roof of the existing rear extension as well as replacement windows on the rear ground floor.

The scheme seeks confirmation in the form of a lawful development certificate that the construction of the development described above would constitute permitted development.

Relevant planning history for the site include:

- **03/2089/PS192** – roof extension. **Granted.**

## 4. CONSULTATIONS CARRIED OUT

This is an application for a Certificate of Lawful Development (Proposed), which is a request to the Council to confirm that the development as specified does not require an application for planning permission to be submitted to the Council. In assessing this application, the Council is making a determination of law, and as such it is not considered to be necessary to undertake a public consultation.

## 6. EXPLANATION OF RECOMMENDATION

The application site is a dwellinghouse, and the application will be assessed against Schedule 2, Part 1 of the Town and Country (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 (as amended), which relates to "Development within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse".

The alterations to the single storey rear extension will be assessed under Class A.
