
Site Location

The Barnes Hospital site is located off of South Worple Way in Barnes, London. The original hospital building on site, opened 1889 as The Barnes Isolation Hospital, where it treated patients for infectious diseases such as diphtheria and scarlet fever. The existing buildings were extensively renovated in 2001 when a new extension was added. In more recent history, the hospital is known for providing community and inpatient mental health services.

The site is predominantly surrounded by residential developents. To the north of the site, lies the river Thames. To the west, is the Old Mortlake Cemetary. Further east down South Worple Way, is a direct connection to Barnes Common.

The site is boardered by a variety of existing mature trees on the west and south boarder.
