**Address:** Barnes Hospital South Worple Way East Sheen London SW14 8SU

**Proposal:** Drop-in full application to supersede residential development zone of previously approved Outline planning permission 18/3642/OUT. Demolition of existing structures and redevelopment of site including construction of three new buildings comprising 106 residential units of mixed tenure (Use Class C3), alterations and conversion of two existing buildings for 3 residential use (Use Class C3), car and cycle parking, landscaping and associated works.

**Comment:** I would draw your attention to Design & access statement 2 - Existing and nearby 4 storey developments. This page is a total fabrication and the locations on the map are not where the existing buildings (pictured) actually are. In all cases the map locations have been moved closer the proposed site. Why would this be? So I object to the density & layout - and the 4 storey height - of the proposed development, which is out of character with the surrounding area. I also suggest that the adequacy of the parking provision is simply not enough for the number of planned dwellings. Furthermore road access for so many new dwellings, being forced to use South Worple Way/White Hart Lane or Queens Road, would be unsustainable and dangerous in the local, residential area.
