

### **DETAILED INFORMATIVES**

#### U0056977 TPO T1098

This decision does not obviate the protection afforded to the Eucalyptus under TPO T1098. Of particular concern is the possibility of damage to the rooting system through soil compaction from nearby works and access, therefore please submit a method statement detailing how works will be undertaken to avoid damage and compaction.

Anyone who contravenes an Order by damaging or carrying out work on a protected tree, or causes or permits prohibited activities, without permission from the Council is guilty of an offence. If convicted by the magistrates court the person(s) may be liable for fines up to a maximum of £20,000. Serious cases may be tried in the Crown court which can impose unlimited fines.

The Council may also pursue prosecution under the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 which provides for the recovery or confiscation of the financial benefit gained from criminal activity. Typically, the unauthorised works lead to the increase in value of neighbouring properties. In one instance prosecuted by Poole Borough Council, the increase in value was calculated to exceed £20,000 requiring the homeowner to pay a confiscation order, the prosecution costs of £15,000 and a fine of £1,200 (a total which exceeded £37,000). When a confiscation order is made the court fixes the term of imprisonment to be served in default of payment of confiscation order - serving a term of imprisonment does not discharge the confiscation order.
