Proposal: Drop-in full application to supersede residential development zone of previously approved Outline planning permission 18/3642/OUT. Demolition of existing structures and redevelopment of site including construction of three new buildings comprising 106 residential units of mixed tenure (Use Class C3), alterations and conversion of two existing buildings for 3 residential use (Use Class C3), car and cycle parking, landscaping and associated works.

Comment: Whilst I am in support for better use of vacant real estate, I do not believe due consideration has been given to the challenges of heavy goods vehicles and increased traffic getting to and from the site. The key junction at White Hart Lane is already dangerous, in part due to South Worpole Way being a single carriageway, the junction often reaching complete gridlock waiting for the barriers to come up and, due to the frequency of trains, the frantic manoeuvring of vehicles to get through the crossing before the gates close again. I do not believe the increased risk has been given anywhere near the level of consideration required. If the council was to watch the traffic flow on an average day I am sure the only conclusion is that it is simply not safe or viable for any construction vehicles to service the site from this approach. I am also not sure what other options there would be as there are similar challenges from the other side of South Worpole Way.
