**Address:** Barnes Hospital South Worples Way East Sheen London SW14 8SU

**Proposal:** Drop-in full application to supersede residential development zone of previously approved Outline planning permission 18/3642/OUT. Demolition of existing structures and redevelopment of site including construction of three new buildings comprising 106 residential units of mixed tenure (Use Class C3), alterations and conversion of two existing buildings for 3 residential use (Use Class C3), car and cycle parking, landscaping and associated works.

**Comment:** How do you expect residents to review the documents within such a short timeline - and over the Christmas period? It's rushed and goes against the original 2018 outline planning agreement that all three functions of this site be viewed together. This application facilitates the residential developer only so key issues like transport and access, massing and sustainability are not clear to locals across the whole site. Should this application be considered by itself, the developer is free to progress while the Trust's vital SEMH school and Health Hub, the heart of this development, await planning. This can't be right and I'd like to review all three plans concurrently to determine impact on traffic, parking, congestion and access. Pls extend the period for reviewing plans until all three developments can be assessed at the same time - as agreed back in 2018.
