Type of comment: Object to the proposal

Comment: The proposal's "Flood risk assessment & drainage strategy" document of 18 November 2021 reports as conclusions that "the site in FoodZone 1 is at low risk of flooding". However, an environmental search report by Argyll Environmental states that "there to be a risk of flooding within 50m of the search centre, i.e. 30 Grosvenor Avenue." Section 2 of the foretold report provides further information and specifically refers to risks of "river flooding, surface water flooding, flooding from rivers and sea, and groundwater flooding". It is not conceivable that the Barnes Hospital, situated at a straight line distance of 50m, be considered at no risk of flooding.
