4. Description of Proposed Works Please describe details of the proposed development or works including details of proposals to alter, extend or demolish the listed building(s):				
Rebuilding of the collapsed and loose sections of the plinth using salvaged bricks with some new matching bricks to make up losses. New and salvaged bricks will be blended to avoid banding variations. New bonding bricks and stainless-steel bed joint reinforcement and ties will be incorporated to improve the bond with the existing. A mortar fillet will top the plinth to mitigate water traps and build-up of seedlings in organic debris. Partial dismantling and rebuilding of a further 25- 30 linear metres of the top of the plinth required to remove Buddleia plants rooted in the wall fabric to restore the topmost 2-4 courses of the plinth. Rebuilding the top of the wall as existing in 3no. isolated areas where deeply embedded Buddleia roots are cracking and dislodging the brickwork
