

We would plant long-lived perennial plants to attract wildlife and create excellent biodiversity




Existing trees at the rear of the garden would be pruned to good health, then underplanted with layers of native and non-native shrubs and ground-cover plants






Existing shrubs like the Euphorbia, Choisya, Anemanthele grasses would be planted under trees and around the lawn




Native ferns and flowering perennials would be planted around the lawn




Working with the local Wildlife Trust we would plant species of plants which would support the biodiversity
