The area already has two good secondary schools with capacity to take on additional pupils. The opening up of a new school would only lead to fewer pupils at the two existing schools. You only have to look at the local primary schools. Those asked to expand to three-form entry are now undersubscribed as demand for schools in the area has significantly dropped over the past few years. Where is this extra demand coming from? Those who would usually go private? The two local schools have worked incredibly hard over the past few years to appeal to local children and parents.
