**Comment:** Why the council are wedded to scheme I have no idea; there appears to be no need for a school of this size and age group. On the doorstep for the recent council elections the LibDem candidates were all opposed to the main plans for the brewery site but were much more equivocal about this. It clearly made them uncomfortable to support it but equally they wouldn't oppose it either so there is clearly a political dimension to this. With the landslide victory the party just had surely it is time to think again rather than cling to plans originally proposed when there was a different party in charge.

The plans are an act of vandalism on a perfectly useable sports field and siting so large a school in an area where traffic is routinely congested and a station that is overcrowded seem an extreme folly. At the moment there are only two trains an hour in each direction when children will be going home which will result in overcrowded platforms. Please reconsider this plan.
