**Comment:** I continue to object to the squeezing in of a secondary school in the proposed development because of:

The loss of protected OOLTI open space which is not off-set by compliant re-provisioning

The space available being unsuitable for a school of 1150 pupils. I understand that the site will be around 30% of the DfE's recommended size for that school population.

Given inadequate recreational space, it is even more likely that secondary school pupils will spill out of the site during breaks in an area where already heavy traffic creates an unsafe environment both in terms of accident risk and pollution. The transport and road infrastructure will struggle to support the increase in school-related movement at the beginning and end of the day, leading to an even greater risk of accident at the Sheen Level crossing and further congestion and pollution in an area already suffering from both. The closure of Hammersmith Bridge for an unknown length of time exacerbates the problem.
