As you will be aware that the area already suffers from extreme levels of traffic with Hammersmith bridge closed and the railway crossing. This has already reduced air quality, and should these works go ahead as planned this will decrease further. Not only should Hammersmith bridge be dealt with first, the density of the proposed house is, in my opinion, going to have a detrimental impact on the local environment and character of Mortlake. The proposed changes are not significantly different to those rejected by the Mayor, and do not address the concerns raised by the local community.
