I'm writing to express my strong reservations about the plans to build housing and a school and so on at the old brewery site in Mortlake. As everyone knows who lives round here (and I live on Cowley Road, SW14 8QD), the traffic is a nightmare. Often I've cancelled trips, turned round in my car and gone home, because of the traffic jams.

This is, put simply, an overdeveloped place already - too many people living in a space squeezed between the river and the railway. The development will ruin the area and make me want to move out of it. The whole character of Mortlake would change. Not enough thought has been put into the consequences of the potential development - a real mess lies ahead if it is pushed through.
