


2 PROPOSED GROUND FLOOR PLAN

LBRuT Rufuse and recycling storage requirements for commercial developments is suggested to be 2.6m³ for every 1,000m² gross floor space.

The Richmond MakerLabs has a gross floor space of 130m² so the required storage should be 2.6m³.

50% of this capacity should be retained for the storage of separated waste for recycling.

2 x 7701 bins (1,220 (w) x 770 (l) x 1,360 (h)) would provide this 2.6m 3 requirement.

The bins will be located in the enclosed outdoor space and brought to the street frontage on collection days.
