Strategy - Sustainable Drainage

- Intention to provide SUDS to relieve
 pressure on existing surface water system
 and create new habitat within the site.
- + Infiltration Basin situated to the North, approximately half way across site
- Low point in relation to primary hardstanding areas where run-off volume will be greater
- + Located in an open area means no need for tree removal
- + Collection point for run-off from hardstanding pathways
- Area devoid of primary ecological features minimising need for removal of trees or other features.
- + Wetland Planting to add to ecological enhancement in the infiltration basin.

Strategy - Boundary Treatment





Weld mesh sports fencing around tennis and hockey court.

Acoustic fence with planting to create acoustic and visual screening parallel to the eastern boundary of the hockey pitch as advised by the acoustic consultant.

Acoustic fence will be a 3m high timber fence with climbing plants

No other pitches will be fenced and they will remain open, as existing, as recommended by the acoustic consultant.

Existing Eastern boundary facing Duke of Cambridge Close, there is additional tree planting along this border.
