Last planned garden from 1984 retained and updated where necessary to establish a beautiful, practical and manageable garden in keeping with the historic house and new proposal.

KEY

1. Long flower bed-country garden planting: Red robins retained. Gardenia Jasminoides 'Kleim's Hardy' by shed, Purple lilac shrub, Mock orange shrubs, Hydrangea petiolaris (climbing on wall), Ivy (climbing along whole length of permitter wall), White jasmine (climbing through on walls), White lupins, Alliums – purple sensation, Scabiosa – Flutter Deep Blue, Agapanthus – Brilliant Blue, Peonies – Coral Charm, Geum – Pretticoats Peach, Helleborus – Snow Rose, Nigella - blue, Irises - Catherine Seville (pink), Anemone - Honorine Jorbert (white), Delphiniums - purple and light blue, Foxgloves - white - purpurea f. albiflora
2. Plants on carport: 3no. bay trees, purple catmint in flower beds, white jasmin trailing at back of carport to provide floral shield
3. Plants behind carport: Young quince tree, young plum trees and red robins retained, white wisteria climbing fence, cover for the roof & structure of carport white jasmin climbing, white wisteria
4. Plants by carport shed: Young pear trees and young plum tree retained. Mixture of irises - Bryan's best blue and white city
5. Raised bed for vegetables: Vegetable bed beside established fig tree
6. Flower bed: Wisteria sinensis (purple) growing up side of building
7. Simple outdoor dining area
8. Soakaway
9. Grey cobblestones
10. Newly reburish front garden already in place
11. Young plum and apple tree retained
